## Transfer Pattern

(Semesters)

Loma Linda University offers BS, MS, and Doctoral degrees in Nursing. An AS degree option which prepares the student for the NCLEX-RN exam may be completed in 5-6 quarters after completion of prerequisites and admission into the program. The BS degree requires 7-8 quarters after completion of prerequisites and admission into the program.

ALTERNATE TRACKS are available for RN's, LVN's, and individuals with bachelor's degrees in other areas. ADN graduates must obtain an RN license before applying for admission to the BS degree program. RN's may complete the BSN in just 4 quarters of full time study if all other prerequisites are met.

The following courses must be completed with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 before beginning clinical nursing classes at Loma Linda University.
