Introductory Physics

AHCJ 111 (4 units) & AHCJ 112 (4 units)

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Two-course sequence introducing the science and concepts of physics. Meets the physics prerequisite requirement for many programs in the School of Allied Health Professions.

AHCJ 111 - Autumn Quarter

September 22 - December 12, 2008/ Registration begins August 25, 2008

Focuses on mechanics, properties of matter and heat, emphasizing concepts. Three lecture hours and three laboratory hours per week. Designed for students entering programs in the allied health sciences and nursing.

Prerequisite: High school algebra or equivalent

AHCJ 112 - Winter Quarter

January 5 - March 20, 2009/ Registration begins December 8, 2008

Focuses on sound, light, electricity and magnetism, atomic and nuclear physics, and relativity. Emphasizes concepts. Three lecture hours and three laboratory hours per week. Designed for students entering programs in the allied health sciences and nursing. *Prerequisite: High school algebra or equivalent.*
