ANATOMY AND PHYSIOLOGY

AHCJ 250 (4 units) & AHCJ 251 (4 units)

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Courses cover structure and function of the human body. The two quarter, 8 unit, course is prerequisite for students applying to programs in the School of Allied Health Professions such as cardiopulmonary sciences, emergency medical technology, health information management, occupational therapy, physical therapy, physical therapist assistant, radiation technology, speech pathology and audiology, and surgical technology. This course is also prerequisite for nursing and the bachelor of science degree in public health. **Must be taken in sequence.**

AHCJ 250 Autumn Quarter

September 22 - December 12, 2008/ Registration begins August 25, 2008

Human anatomy and physiology with emphasis on cell structure and function, and the following organ systems: integumentary, skeletal, muscle and nervous. (One 3-hour lecture and one 3-hour lab per week.)

AHCJ 251 Winter Quarter

January 5 - March 20, 2009/ Registration begins December 8, 2008

Human anatomy and physiology with emphasis on the following organ systems: endocrine, cardiovascular, respiratory, digestive, urinary and reproductive. (One 3-hour lecture and one 3-hour lab per week.). *Prerequisite: AHCJ 250 or equivalent.*
